#### <u>100's</u>

140 AD-Justin Martyr

157 AD - Montanists of Phyrgia. (Philadelphia) Pentecostal sisters: Prisca & Maximilla prophecied in tongues. Montanists Alive in England in 1700's

The following wrote of the speaking on tongues phenomena in their particular era.

177 AD- Irenaeus saw nations of glossalalists in Europe

177 AD - Tongues speaking Montanists in Gaul

# <u>200's</u>

220 AD- Alogi tongues speakers & gifts in Europe, Asia, China, & North Africa.

- 230 AD- Tertullian : "Tongues speaking Monarchians out-number the Catholics"
- 270 AD Mani (Manichaeus bar Barak) tongue speakers from Glastonbury, Eng to China

# <u>300's</u>

**304-AD**- Glastonbury church of England Montanists & Acts 2:38

330-AD-Wolflein Preacher(Wolflein's Gothic Bible). Glossalalists -

Baptized in Jesus Name among European tribes.

397-AD - Catholic bishop Ambrose mentioned tongues among the Persians, Italians, and Asian Indians

# <u>400's</u>

- **419-500-AD** Languedoc area of France, Cevennes Mountains. Apostolics thrived. French historians called them the "tongues speakers of Cevennes" Many Hueguenots were converted to Oneness Pentecostalism
- **430-AD** Augustine fought militarily against the glossalalists.

Yet, utterances among the Alogi, Anti-Nicenes, Antitrinitarians, & Unitarians

431-AD Nestorians were Acts 2:38 and Pentecostals

**440-AD** Catholics run out of Armenia followed by One God Pentecostal revival Oneness Pentecostalism traveled in most christian bodies:

Celtics, Saxony, Netherlands, Montanists, Manichee, Nestorians, Samosatenes, Artemonites.

440-461-AD Pope Leo 1 spoke of Pentecostals in the empire.

Slandered Cathari among Huns, Slavs, Franks, Goths, Visigoths, Ostrogoths, Celts, Soxons.

476-AD-Origen : "hated monotheistic Ebionites of Palestine"

# <u>500's</u>

**502-AD**-Wolfleins Acts 2:38 preaching brought W. Europe tribes into Pentecostalism & Jesus name **527-AD**-Many Burgundians were Apostolic Pentecostals

**536-563-AD** PRISCILLIANISM - glossalalic throughout the Old World **545-800-AD**-Apostolics were throughout England **597-AD**-Augustine

#### <u>600's</u>

#### Glossalalia by Judeo-Christian Desposyni

(Near East Jewish bishops who traced their roots to Mary & Joseph, Elizabeth & Zechariah **663-AD**-Apostolic Pentecostal Celts had been in Glastonbury England since 42 AD.

Pentecostal spread into the Traskites, Quakers, Shakers, Irvingites

**691-AD** Asia Minor had Oneness Apostolic Pentecostals : Christian Armenians, Samosatenes, Montanists, Manichaeans, Marcionites, Artemonites

#### <u>700's</u>

700's - Albert preached Apostolic simplicity

**743-AD** Pope Zachary & Boniface found non-Catholics widespread. They improperly baptize, immerse completely under in the name of Jesus Christ,...the ancient superstitution.

#### <u>900's</u>

915-AD Pelagius of Cordova died for his Oneness testimony

923-AD Eugenia of Cordova died for her Oneness testimony

#### <u>1000's</u>

**1040** AD- Manichaeans Apostolic Pentecostals. Bog-o-mils (God's-Mercy)

1050 AD- 1000 towns of Languedoc controled by Albibensians (Oneness Pentecostals) up to the

1233 AD beginning of the Inquisition to 1834 Southern France and Western Germany (Saxony)

#### <u>1100's</u>

**1100's** Abbess, Hildegard of Bingen sang in unknown tongues

1100's Glossalalists Vincent Ferrer taught pentecost in France, Spain, & N. Italy

1147-AD Called Apostolics in Toulouse, France

- **1145-AD** Dean of Notre Dame in Arras said one third of Catholics there went to secret conventicular (Pentecostal AnaBaptist) meetings
- **1150's-AD** -Albigenses (France) latter 12<sup>th</sup> century 1150's1208 Pope Innocent III had them slaughtered.**1150's-AD** -Waldenses (France) latter 12<sup>th</sup> century 1150'sMerged in 1458 with Moravians tongue speak
- **1150's-AD** -Waldenses (France) latter 12<sup>th</sup> century 1150's Merged in 1458 with Moravians tongue speakers. Many fled into Moravia of Czechoslovakia
- 1161-AD Oneness Apostolic Gerard and about 30 others were killed by the King of England
- **1163-AD** Pentencostals Arnold, Marsilius and Theodoric with 5 other men, 2 women a girl
  - were killed in Catholic Cologne, Germany at a Jewish cemetary by Monk Ecbert.

They told him to be saved he had to be baptized with the Holy ghost and fire.

#### <u>1300's</u>

1315 AD-Apostolic tongues speakers in Europe

# <u>1400's</u>

1492-AD Columbus took with him some African glossalalists slaves to Haiti

1498-AD Malabarese Apostolics of India still spoke in tongues

# <u>1500's</u>

1525-AD Pentecostal utterances of Donatists agitated European Reformer Protestant Preachers

1528-AD Outbreak of miracles and glossalalia from Appenzell to Moravia

In Fulda; experiential healings and Spirit glossalalia similar to the Pentecostal outbreaks among the St. Gall Anabapists.

- **1530-AD** Felix Mantz drowned in Lammat river by Zwingli --- Zwingli had only negative comments about the tongues speakers of his day; epileptic symptons in worship
- 1530's-AD Rev Bernard Rothmann, pentecostal, baptized more than 1400 in the name of Jesus Christ in Munster, Germany. Obbe Phillips, Oneness, baptized Menno Simons in Jesus name after he left the Catholic Religion. Many Mennonite clergy were glossalalists & baptized in the name of Christ while in Europe.

1551-AD Samosaten Armenian Christianity of Thessalonica

- 1560's-AD 1580's European Anabaptists Tongue speaking & Acts 2:38 Organizations
- **1565-AD** Enough Apostolic Pentecostal Oneness to form "International Federation of Apostolic Churches" - Micahel Servetus burned to death by John Calvin
- 1568-AD Macantonio Varotto counted 40 Anabaptist groups, many were Acts 2 Apostolic
- 1572-AD Huguenots fled massacre into Cevenne Mountains Comisard Oneness Apostolic communities some later settled in Lowell, Ohio

#### <u>1600's</u>

- 1630-AD The Samosatene Armenian Christians of Asia Minor (Macedonia) still flourished
- 1656-AD Mary Fisher & Ann Austin Quaker tongues-speakers were imprisoned. No tithes to State Church.
- 1660's-AD Pentecostal Quakers in Massachuetts, many Denied the Trinity, some Acts 2:38 The Conventicle & Five Mile Act passed against glossalalisits Quakers & other non-Anglcans. Tongue speakers deported: Men to Barbados, Women to Jamaica
- **1660's-AD** Tongues speaking Quakers settled in North Carolina
  - ~ Later Lynchites also settled in North Carolina
- 1662-AD in British Isles large numbers of Holy Spirit verblizers, tongues speakers, Quakers, Shakers, Moravians, Samosatenes, Donatists, Montanists, Huguenots, Roarers, Seekers, Ranters, Wales Jumpers, Plymouth Brethern

Some were deported sold as slaves to rich Spanish Catholic family plantations in Jamacia

1682-AD - Quaker William Penn acquainted with George Fox & tongues speaking , founded Pennsylvania

# <u>1700's</u>

1700's-AD - Montanists Alive in England in 1700's

**1720's-AD** -Benjamin Franklin was impressed by his 1<sup>st</sup> employer, a Comisard glossalalists of the European French Prophets.

**1727-AD** - English outbreak of Pentecostal Moravians in London. John Roche heard the glossalalist out-break and called it "a ridiculous piece of nonsense" by a  $2^{nd}$  century sect.

**1728-AD** - 1824 In Europe : 96 years of uncountable divine healings, receivings of the Holy Spirit and tongues speaking. It broke out among Convulsionaries and Jansenists, many of St. Medard : a familiar phrase "recevez le sceau do saint espirit". One account of 200 miracles from 1728 - 1731. "Voltaire" said it was 500-600 miracles.

1736-AD - Moravian communities in Carolinas and Georgia (even in 1880's)

1750's-AD- Moravian Count N. Von Zinzendorf

1779-AD - @ Preaching of Joseph Meachem of Connecticut

1786-AD - Ann Lee & Jamima Wilkinson pentecostals, denied the Trinity

#### 1800's

1800-AD 1801 University of Georgia Revival with speaking in tongues

**1830's-AD -** Edward Irvings Preaching in England ~ Presbyterian Church on Regent's Square in London ~ Later Deposed

One Encyclopedia accounts glossalia as : the speaking in tongues of the Camisards, Prophets of the Cevennes, Early Quakers, Methodists, and Mormons, Lasare Sweden (1842), Irish revival converts of 1859, and the Irvingite Church (1830's)

- 1852-AD A thriving Lynchite organization existed in North Carolina prior to 1852
- 1854-AD V.P. Frost told of New England tongues interpretations by Elder Edwin Burnham
- 1856-AD 160,000 +- Quakers in America, many were Pentecostal
- 1848-AD glossalia & Acts 2:38 was wide spread among the Lynchites of North Carolina
- 1850-AD Daniel Lee's Oneness Apostolic Pentecostal Family & ~ Billy's Island ~ Okefenokee Swamp ~GA. FLA Called themselves Primitive Baptists because they retained the old ways -refused modern baptism
- **1800's-AD** Slaves in America were over-heard singing Gospel songs, praying and some speaking in tongues around evening camp fires in one southern state.
- 1880's-AD A NewsPaperMan witnessed tongues speaking at a Girls School in India ran by Pandita Ramabai
- 1873-AD Accompanied D.L. Moody's Preaching @ London's YMCA Victoria Hall Meeting & at other times
- 1876's-AD Accompanied the ministry of Mary Woodworth Etter (not personally) of the United Brethern Church
- 1888-AD Alvin E. Velie preached along the Mississippi River baptizing thousands in Jesus Name
- **1890's-AD** Tongues speaking Quite common @ Preaching of Benjamin Irwin ~ Fire Baptized Holiness Church ~ Lincoln, Nebraska
- **1896-AD** Western North Carolina Revival Coker Creek, Tn ~ Adults & children Later became the Church of God of Cleveland, TN

#### <u>1900's</u>

**1900-AD** - Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> Charles Parham ~ Topeka, Kansas ~ Bethel Bible School ~ Angnes Ozman & 40 students

1904-AD - Welsh Revival under Roberts preaching ~ young men and women

1906-AD - April 9 W. J. Seymour & 7 others (Black folks) Azusa St. ~ Los Angeles 3 year revival Armenian immigrant Magardich Mushegan of Los Angeles visited Azusa but had the Holy Ghost from long before it began
