## **TESTIMONY & ARK**

- Ex 25:16 And thou shalt put into the ark the testimony which I shall give thee.
- Ex 25:21 And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt **put the testimony** that I shall give thee.
- Ex 26:33 And thou shalt hang up the vail under the taches, that thou mayest bring in thither within the vail **the ark of the testimony**: and the vail shall divide unto you between the holy place and the most holy.
- Ex 27:21 In the tabernacle of the congregation without the vail, which is **before the testimony**, Aaron and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: it shall be a statute for ever unto their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel.
- Ex 30:6 And thou shalt put it before the vail **that is by the ark of the testimony**, before the mercy seat that is over the testimony, where I will meet with thee.
- Ex 34:29 And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with **the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand,** when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.
- Ex 38:21 This is the **sum of the tabernacle, even of the tabernacle of testimony**, as it was counted, according to the commandment of Moses, for the service of the Levites, by the hand of Ithamar, son to Aaron the priest.
- Ex 40:3 And thou shalt put therein the ark of the testimony, and cover the ark with the vail.
- Ex 40:5 And thou shalt set the **altar of gold for the incense before the ark of the testimony**, and put the hanging of the door to the tabernacle.
- Nu 1:50 But thou shalt **appoint the Levites over the tabernacle of testimony**, and over all the vessels thereof, and over all things that belong to it: they shall bear the tabernacle, and all the vessels thereof; and they shall minister unto it, and shall encamp round about the tabernacle.
- Nu 1:53 But the **Levites shall pitch round about the tabernacle of testimony,** that there be no wrath upon the congregation of the children of Israel: and the Levites shall keep the charge of the tabernacle of testimony.
- Nu 4:5 And when **the camp setteth forward**, Aaron shall come, and his sons, and they shall take down the covering vail, and **cover the ark of testimony** with it:
- Nu 7:89 And when Moses was gone into the tabernacle of the congregation to speak with him, then he heard the voice of one speaking unto him from off the mercy seat that was upon the ark of testimony, from between the two cherubims: and he spake unto him.
- Nu 9:15 And on the day that the tabernacle was reared up **the cloud covered the tabernacle**, **namely, the tent of the testimony:** and at even there was upon the tabernacle as it were the appearance of fire, until the morning.

Nu 17:10 And the LORD said unto Moses, **Bring Aaron's rod again before the testimony, to be kept for a token against the rebels;** and thou shalt quite take away their murmurings from me, that they die not.

Ex 16:33 And Moses said unto Aaron, Take a pot, and put an omer full of manna therein, and lay it up before the LORD, to be kept for your generations.

Heb 9:4 Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant;

Heb 9:5 And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercyseat; of which we cannot now speak particularly.
