## GOD'S TESTIMONY IN THE EARTH

# THE WILDERNESS

The Christian World mentality is that the "wilderness experience phase" is a period of our life we must pass thru to enter the more comfortable – "abundant fruitful phase" experience. That seems again to be the natural mind's rationale to get through the bad to get to the pleasant. Again the ultimate purpose is to satisfy the flesh, even at the cost of a barren place on our way to prosperity and abundance. <u>I don't believe this now.</u>

One description of the wilderness of the scripture is a place of barrenness, arid and dry, void, where life doesn't grow nor thrives. It is a place cut off from life, inhabited by scary creatures. A scary place, a place of chaos, a place of wandering, of restlessness. The habitation of Satan, the Devil, the Dragon.

The nation of Israel were led, directed, driven into the wildernes the same as Jesus was driven by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tested and confronted with the powers of darkness and evil, ...the Devil. Matthew reveals it as a place of days of hunger, fasting, and Temptation, with angels ministering afterward. Mark said it was a place of wild beasts, yet a place where angels ministered to Jesus.

# THE WILDERNESS SCHOOL ... is a place we are... (Deut 8:2,3,5)

1>LED INTO, Guided into, Taken into, Driven into places & events ... by the SPIRIT

2>PROVEN, Tested, Assayed .... By situations designed ...by the SPIRIT

3><u>HUMBLED</u>, Self is Abased, Brow-beated .... By circumstances designed ...by the SPIRIT

4><u>CHASTENED</u>, admonished, taught, instructed, disciplined ...by the SPIRIT

THE WILDERNESS FOR God's firstborn Son - ISRAEL, for JESUS, for EACH BELIEVER ....IT WAS & IS FILLED WITH PURPOSE, EXPERIENCES, GUIDANCE, & PREPARATION for lifetime of JOURNEY & WALK with our God in this earth as his testimony. *(note the pattern for us : Jesus' ministry began in Wilderness Testing and ended in Testing on the Cross ....My God, My God, why have you forsaken me ??? )* 

## The FUNCTION of the FORTY'S ---- 40 YEARS / 40 DAYS-NIGHTS

Several issues or principles are engaged in the wilderness... Testing, Teaching, Correcting,....and removing of Un-Belief. One critical aspect of the 40 years was to consume all of those adults who were of UNBELIEF.

### UNBELIEF was a principle purging issue.

"And the LORD'S anger was kindled against Israel, and he made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation, that had done evil in the sight of the LORD, was consumed."

"For the children of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness, till all the people that were men of war, which came out of Egypt, were consumed, because they obeyed not the voice of the LORD: unto whom the LORD sware that he would not shew them the land, which the LORD sware unto their fathers that he would give us, a land that floweth with milk and honey." "For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by

Moses. But with whom was he grieved forty years? was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcases fell in the wilderness?"

"Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief." Numbers 32:13; Joshua 5:6; Hebrews 3:16, 17; 4:11, KJV.

# An 11 day Journey became a Life-Time .....40 years Deut 1:2-3

What looks to the natural man as a short trip becomes a life-time experience.

There are only Two Places of Existence in this Earth Realm :

### Paradise: .....which is God's Realm

Peace / Prosperity / Blessing / No Curse /God Fellowship

### <u>Wilderness:</u>.....which is Satan's Realm

Land of Curse / Desolation / Despair ....it is that place of Satan's throne, his area of governing, ...enthronement and power. It is a place where the child of God can not exist in life or live without the support and life of the Spirit.

God took Israel literally into the Wilderness upon their exit from the bondage of Sin & Egypt. He took them to a place of desolation, death, and curse.

In the wilderness, they learned that ....when surrounded by Death,...God would bring them Life. ....that even in Desolation, ...God would be their plenty .... In an envirnment of Cursed-ness, ....God would bring blessing.

# God became their literal support and literal source in all areas of their existence. God would be their Life!

## **QUESTIONS ABOUT THE WILDERNESS ?**

**How Will we Live there?** There's Nothing to Support Life there?? Yet, God would be their Support. He is Life. In Death....they Lived. In Desolation....they had Plenty. In Curse....they were Blessed!

-Not 1 river during all there wanderings

-John the Baptist was raised there

- -Israel ate Manna there
- -It was a place to pastor flocks
- -It was a place where water is the 1 vital thing between existing in Life & Death
- -It was a place of DISCIPLINE
- -It was a place the Spirit leads or drives us into

-Moses went... Jesus went... Led of the Spirit into Wilderness ... Driven into Wilderness

**MOSES:** Leader of Nation & Israel as a Nation .... Moses lived there for 40 years as his previous Egyptian Life was gradually erased on all levels.

JESUS: Leader of Nation & Israel as a Natilon ....

Jesus was driven or led there by the Spirit for 40 days of testing, trial, temptation

-It is where the Scapegoat is driven with the curse of all Israel's sins away from human life ....into a place of desolation and forsakenness with the burden of all Israel's sins

### FORTY-TWO ENCAMPMENTS in the WILDERNESS ... (NUM 33:1,50-52) ... in 40 Yrs

IT ALL APPEARS TO THE NATURAL MAN AS ... WANDERINGS BUT TO THE SPIRITUAL MAN IT IS WALKING & JOURNEYING WITH GOD

A LIFE-TIME of ... JOURNEY ... DISCIPLINE ... LEADERSHIP ... SCHOOLING ... EMPOWERING

### THE WILDERNESS DISTANCE

DISTANCE : 11 DAY JOURNEY ...... 40 YEAR JOURNEY TO WEED OUT thru DEATH .....UN-BELIEF, FLESH & NATURAL MIND ,...etc JOSH & CALEB (got there Quicker - Another Spirit in Them)

The Wilderness is not ....a literal physical distance...miles, kilometers, etc.. The Wilderness is not ....a literal physical time distance...hours, days, months, years...

<u>WILDERNESS IS THE DISTANCE BETWEEN US</u> (natural man) & CHRIST (spiritual man) ...He that has begun a good work in you, shall perform it until the day of Jesus Christ Phip 1:6

Believers ... AFTER THE FLESH VERSUS Believers ... AFTER THE SPIRIT

The Distance between following ....after the Flesh or after the Spirit The distance between Christ & Us ...is impossible to bridge without the Spirit of the only one who has accomplished it.

The great distance is due to the great difference between us!

All that is in the world ... the lust of the eye, lust of the flesh, and the pride of life 1Jo 2:15-17

### THE WILDERNESS A PLACE OF DEATH...

It was death to a generation who murmured & walked in UN-BELIEF. They represented unbelief so they --- the UN-BELIEF ---- had to die out. A place of death for the Un-Belief.

"For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses. But with whom was he grieved forty years? was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcases fell in the wilderness?" Hebrews 3:16, 17, KJV.

<u>Heb 4:6</u>\* Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of **unbelief**: <u>Heb 4:11</u>\* Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of **unbelief**.

DEATH .....DEATH FOR WHO ...not Christ ...ME, ...the Natural Un-Believing Carnal, Fleshly Man....Me !

### TAKE UP MY CROSS

Mt 10:38 And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me.

*Mt* 16:24 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and **take up his cross, and follow me**.
