the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort (consolation, solace);(2Co 1:3)

...Be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the LORD hath comforted his people, and <u>will have mercy</u> upon his afflicted.(Isa 49:13-16)

Blessed be God, hath not turned away my prayer, nor his mercy from me. (Ps 66:20)

Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy. (Mat 5:7)

Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness <u>and</u> <u>tender mercies</u>;.. Ps 103:4

MIND

Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: (Isa 26:3)

I give you power over all the power of the enemy, (Luk 10:19) and nothing shall harm you, ...not even a hair of my head shall perish. (Luk 21:18)

Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. (1Jo 4:4)

No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper. (Isa 54:17)

When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him (Isa 59:19)

<u>Cast thy burden</u> upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he <u>shall never suffer the</u> <u>righteous to be moved</u>. (Ps 55:22)

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me (Php 4:13)

His grace is sufficient for ME, His strength is made perfect in weakness. (2Co 12:9)

OVER-WHELMED

Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name. (Ps 63:3-4)

<u>Let them praise</u> his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp. (Ps 149:3)

Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. (Ps 150:6)

<u>Sing unto the LORD</u> a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, has gotten him the victory. (Ps 98:1)

Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.

<u>If two of you shall agree</u> on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven. (Mt 18:19)

Isa 56:7 ...for mine house shall be called <u>an house of prayer (**intercession, hymn, supplication)**</u> for all people.

PRIORITIES

<u>Seek first</u> the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. (Mt 6:33)

PROMISES

For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen...(2Co 1:20)

PROTECTION... As the mountains are round about Jerusalem, so the LORD is round about (you) his people from henceforth even for ever. (Ps 125:2)

PROVISION

God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus (Php 4:19)

<u>Cast thy burden</u> upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved. (Ps 55:22)

God furnishes a table in your wilderness ... Trust God Psa 78:19

REFUGE

As for God, his way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried, refined, pure: he is a buckler, shield to all those that trust, take refuge in him.(Ps 18:30)

REJOICE

This is the day that the Lord hath made, I will rejoice and be glad in it. (Psa 118:24)

Sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving & declare his works with rejoicing. (Ps 107:22)

REST

The LORD will perfect that which concerns me: (Ps 138:8)

<u>Take my yoke</u> upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find <u>rest unto your soul</u>. (Mat11:29)

Because you have believed: you do enter into rest ... (He 4:3)

Be still, and know that I am God: (Ps 46:10)

REVEALED

The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, ... (De 29:29)

...Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea the deep things(1Co 2:9-10)

SHELTER

The name of the LORD is a strong tower: righteous runneth into it, & is safe.(Pr 18:10)

SHEPHARD

The LORD is my shepherd; ... I shall not want.

- ... He maketh me to lie down in green pastures; He leadeth me beside the still waters ...He restoreth my soul: He leads me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
- ... Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death; I will fear no evil: For thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.
- ... Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runs over.
- ... **Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me** all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever. (Psa 23:1-6)
